

Dr Bonavina is currently a full-professor of Surgery at the University of Milan Medical School, Milano, Italy. He is the Chief of the Division of General and Foregut Surgery at IRCCS Policlinico San Donato, and Director of the Esophageal Research Center.

Dr. Bonavina is university-board certified in General Surgery and in Thoracic Surgery, and has qualified as Fellow of the European Board of Surgery (FEBS) in general surgery. Over his career, he has performed thousands of surgical procedures on the esophagus, including esophagectomy for cancer and caustic ingestion, repair of paraesophageal hernia, fundoplication and magnetic sphincter augmentation for gastroesophageal reflux disease/Barrett's esophagus, Heller myotomy for esophageal motility disorders, and transoral septum division for Zenker diverticulum. His current research includes biology of Barrett's esophagus, minimally invasive (hybrid, thoracoscopic, laparoscopic, and trans-oral) surgical procedures), surgical oncology, robotic surgery, and surgical education.

Dr. Bonavina is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons since 1995 and has recently been appointed as an Honorary Member (FACS-Hon). He is a member of Académie National de Chirurgie (Paris), European Surgical Association, American Foregut Society, European Society for Diseases of the Esophagus, International Society for Diseases of the Esophagus, Society for Surgery of the Alimentary Tract, and World Society of Emergency Surgery. Dr. Bonavina is also OESO regional officer for Europe and Director of OESO Pilot Center of Excellence in Milan. He is in the board of multiple referee journals and is Associated Editor for Updates in Surgery, the official journal of the Italian Society of Surgery. Dr. Bonavina is the Past-President of the European Foregut Society.
